This is an advanced graduate course examining the legal, political, and economic dimensions of EU policymaking in two key areas: trade (internal and external), and competition. Using an approach that is both multi-disciplinary and comparative, the course considers the historical evolution of the policies, the policy process at EU level, as well as their implementation in the Member States.

Law: Public Law and Constitutional Theory

Course Professor: Christophe Grzegorzcyk. This course introduces the main theories and concepts of Public and Constitutional Law – such as state, sovereignty, constitutionalism, democracy, the rule of law, separation of power, fundamental rights, or judicial review.

Fall 2004

Law: Legal Theory

Course Professor: Christophe Grzegorzcyk. This is a (challenging) introductory course to jurisprudence, discussing the works of Kelsen, Hart, Dworkin, and others. My teaching focused on interpretation and legal positivism.
